Only when the fee is received the final participation of the team will be confirmed.

Rules and Regulations for Pravaah-2018

FOOTBALL

1. Each team will have 7 players on the field and 3 substitutes. Total team size would be 12 members: 7 players, 3 substitutes and 2 reserves.

2. 15 minutes each half with a 5 minutes break between the halves.

3. In the group, each team will get to play league matches. Points distribution will be: WIN - 3 points, LOSS - 0, DRAW - 1 point for each team.

- > Team, which scored higher total goals, will be ranked higher.
- If there is tie in higher total goals, team which conceded total lower goals will be ranked higher.
- In case, after following the above two the tie is not resolved, then Penalty shoot out will be held.

4. Semis and Finals will be decided on Penalty shoot out if the score line is tied after normal time and one extra time of 5 minutes.

5. Players will not be allowed to wear metal studs or metal spikes. Rubber studs or Football shoes are allowed.

6. The decisions on the field are at the discretion of the Referees. Foul play is not advised keeping the fair play spirit in mind. Two yellow cards in a single match would amount to Red card resulting in the player missing the next match and ongoing match also.

7.Substitution: 2 Player Substitution and 1 Goalkeeper substitution will be permitted during the course of the match. Player substituted cannot come to play again in the same match.

8. All the teams will have to adhere to the following rules.

- a) The players should all be permanent employees of the organization or of interconnected companies within a particular group.
- b) Proof of employment will have to be produced by all the participants if asked for by the organizers.
- c) No player can play for more than one team

VOLLEYBALL

1. Each team will have 6 players on the field and 2 substitutes. Total team size would be 10 members: 6 players, 2 substitutes and 2 reserves.

2. The game will finish when one team reaches 25 points first with a difference of atleast 2 points. In case the difference is less than 2 points when one team has reached 25 points then the game will be continued till there is a difference of 2 points between the teams.

3. Scores will be added in increments of 1 whenever the ball hits the ground.

4. In the group, each team will get to play league matches. Points distribution will be: WIN – 3 points, LOSS – 0, DRAW – 1 point for each team.

- > Team, which scored higher total points, will be ranked higher.
- In case there is a tie between two teams in terms of points, then the team will lower points scored against will be ranked higher.
- In case, after following the above two the tie is not resolved, then the team which won the head-to-head match will be ranked higher.

5. Players will not be allowed to wear anything that can hurt players during the play.

6. The decisions on the field are at the discretion of the Referees. Foul play is not advised keeping the fair play spirit in mind.

7. Personal Fouls, technical Fouls, double dribble, 3-second violation, back-court, carrying, travelling, blocking, charging etc. remains as is and will be clarified on field if required.

8. A maximum of 5 personal fouls will be allowed for any individual player in the entire match.

9. Maximum of 5 personal fouls will be allowed for any team in any quarter

10. All the teams will have to adhere to the following rules.

- a) The players should all be permanent employees of the organization or of interconnected companies within a particular group.
- b) Proof of employment will have to be produced by all the participants if asked for by the organizers.
- c) No player can play for more than one team.

BASKETBALL

1. Each team will have 5 players on the field and 3 substitutes. Total team size would be 10 members: 5 players, 3 substitutes and 2 reserves.

2. FOUR Quarters of 6 minutes each with a 3 minutes break between each quarter. Half time will be after the 2nd Quarter. In addition, each team will be allowed to take 1 number of time outs of 2 minutes.

3. Scores will be added in the order of 1,2 or 3 respectively for free throws, 2-pointer and 3-pointers.

4. In the group, each team will get to play league matches. Points distribution will be: WIN - 3 points, LOSS - 0, DRAW - 1 point for each team.

- > Team, which scored higher total points, will be ranked higher.
- If there is tie in higher total goals, team that will have higher total cumulative points will be ranked higher.
- In case, after following the above two the tie is not resolved, then Free Throw-shoot (by any five players) out will be held.

5. Semis and Finals will be decided on Free Throws shoot if the score line is tied after normal time and one extra time of 6 minutes.

6. Players will not be allowed to wear anything that can hurt players during the play.

7. The decisions on the field are at the discretion of the Referees. Foul play is not advised keeping the fair play spirit in mind.

8. Personal Fouls, technical Fouls, double dribble, 3-second violation, back-court, carrying, travelling, blocking, charging etc. remains as is and will be clarified on field if required.

9. A maximum of 5 personal fouls will be allowed for any individual player in the entire match.

10. Maximum of 5 personal fouls will be allowed for any team in any quarter, after these free throws will be given to opponent.

11. All the teams will have to adhere to the following rules.

- d) The players should all be permanent employees of the organization or of interconnected companies within a particular group.
- e) Proof of employment will have to be produced by all the participants if asked for by the organizers.
- f) No player can play for more than one team.

3km Mini Marathon

1. Entrants are required to abide by the Race Rules and marshals' directions.

2. Runner numbers will be allocated to each registered runner. Any runner who competes in another person's race number will be disqualified.

3. The race organizers reserve the right to refuse or cancel applications, including duplicate applications, or alter the date of the event, the course route or distance

4. The race organizers, sponsors, charities, suppliers and/or their agents will not be liable for any injury, loss or expense which may arise in consequence of your participation in this event save as to negligence

5. There is a cut off time for the start - if you arrive later than the scheduled reporting time you will not be allowed to cross the start line.

6. The Pravaah Marathon is a 2-lap course and runners must complete the 2 laps to be designated as finisher. The first lap will be at 1.5 kilometre mark.

7. Race marshals and medical team members have the authority to disqualify and remove any runner they consider to be acting dangerously, or to be unfit to compete.

8. Runners are required to give assistance to fallen runners, and to report any casualties immediately to the nearest first aid post or race marshal

9. In the event of any dispute the decision of the Race Referee and Race Director shall be final

10. Runners are required to run in shoes. Goggles and earphones are optional and may be used by the runners.

11. Overtaking is allowed and must be done without causing obstacles to the fellow runners.

- 12. All the teams will have to adhere to the following rules.
 - a) The runners should all be permanent employees of the organization or of interconnected companies within a particular group.
 - b) Proof of employment will have to be produced by all the participants if asked for by the organizers.
